

Supervision of Children Plan

Teaching staff supervise children primarily by sight. Supervision for short intervals by sound is permissible, as long as teachers check frequently on children who are out of sight.

Children may be out of sight while using the toilet independently, working in center areas, or while napping. During these times, teaching staff will frequently check on them.

Garrett-Keyser-Butler Head Start and Early Head Start classrooms follow the Creative Curriculum classroom set-up and design. This classroom arrangement provides teaching staff with the ability to provide optimal visual supervision of children, as well as, supervision by sound.
